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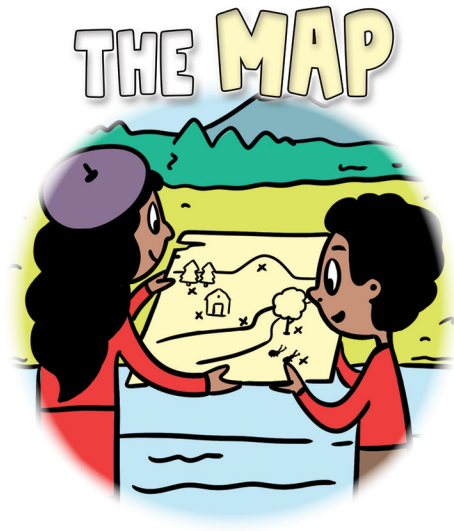

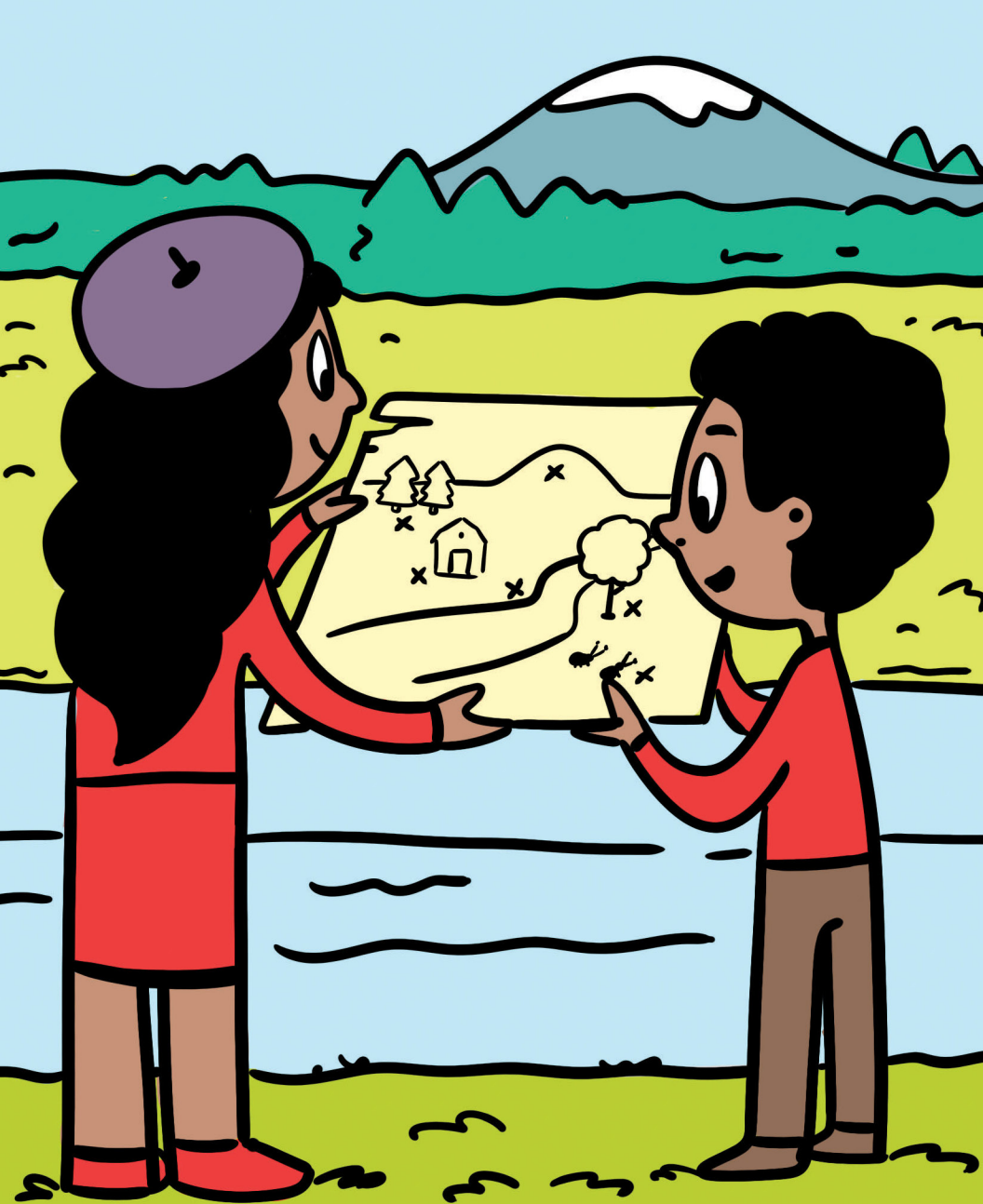


I have a tan map. It has six dots and a rip.

The bugs are lit up! I can jab the net and get a lot of bugs!

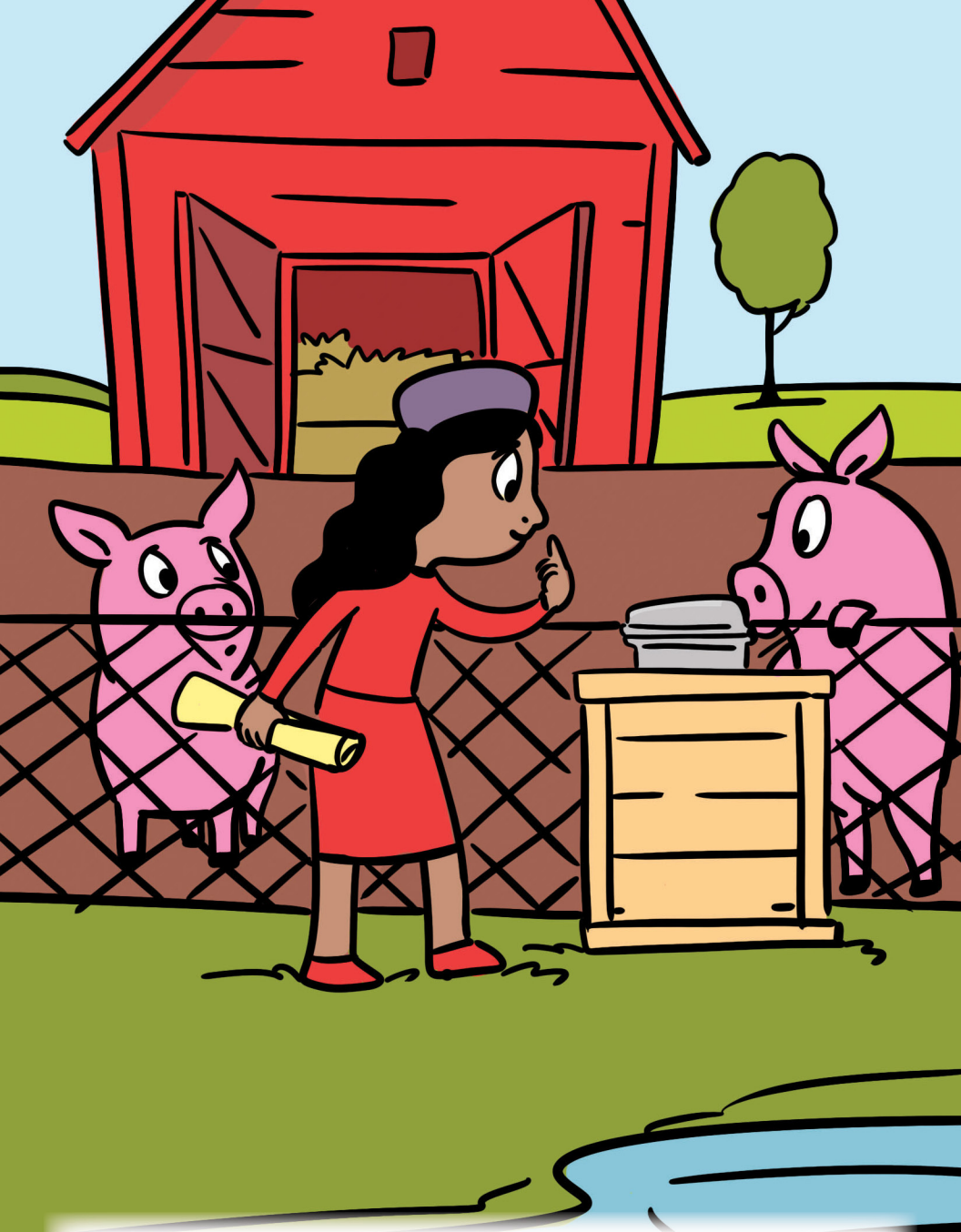




The fog is dim. I do not see

A net is in the tin. What can a net do? *A net can get bugs!*



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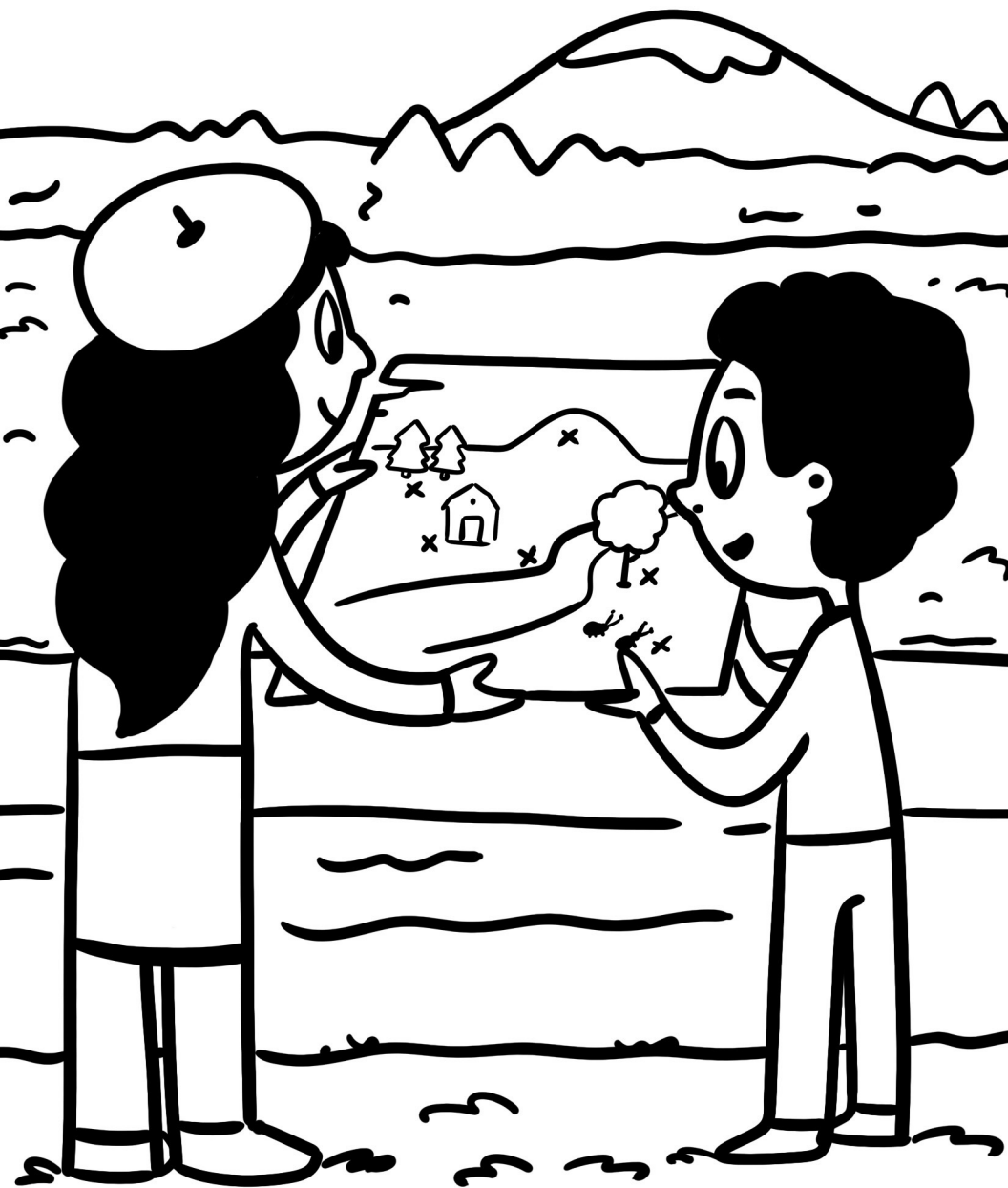


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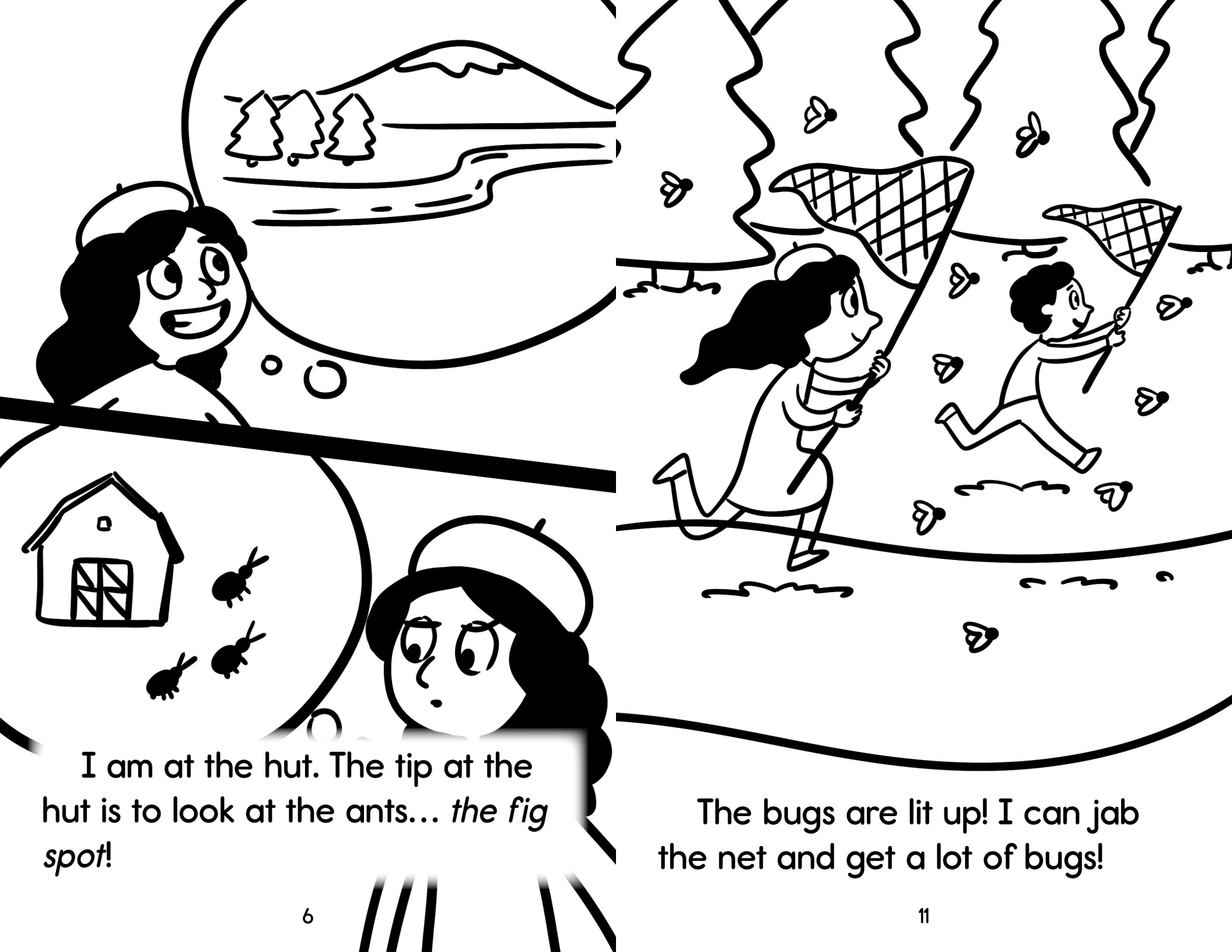




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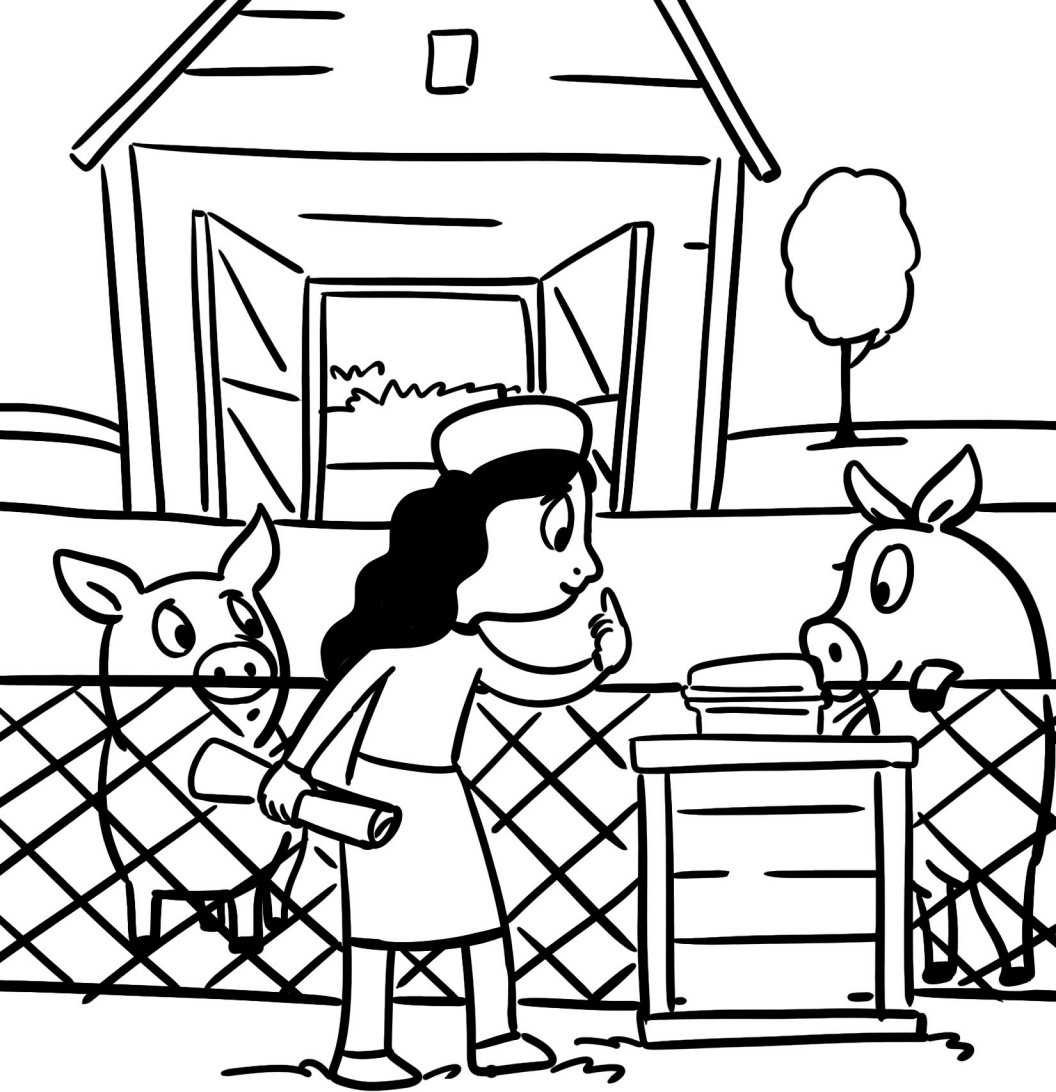
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
